Files marked with an asterisk are sent from the client to BCBSIL. This is the naming convention required by BCBSIL for these specific files.

**mm** = 2-digit month, **dd** = 2-digit day, **I** = 1-digit increment number which begins with “1” and increments each additional file (of the same type) that is transmitted on the same day.

Each of the files sent by BCBSIL is a .zip file which will need to be uncompressed with PKUNZIP when downloaded. When PKUNZIP is run, a file with a .DAT extension will be produced. The uncompressed .DAT file is the file that is run through the BCBSIL claims system.
