IMPROVING ACCESS
TO CARE

A three-year commitment made in 2020 is helping federally qualified health centers bring a program called Centering Pregnancy to more IL communities, focusing on areas with disparities in maternal and infant health outcomes. Group facilitators lead discussions about breastfeeding, domestic violence and family planning options before participants meet their providers for one-on-one health checkups.


