1. Access the Producer Experience Portal.
2. Click on the Blue Access for Producers quick link.
3. Select the state you would like to access for BAPSM.
4. Connect your accounts by entering your Blue Access for Producers ID and Password.

BAP Login Process:

When connecting accounts for the first time, you will need to complete the two-step login process on BAP.

5. Choose how you would like to verify your account (email or typing pattern).
6. Enter your one-time verification code that was sent to you.
7. You will be prompted to continue to the BAP site if your accounts were linked successfully.
8. You now have access to the BAP site.
